### **About Guwahati International Airport Limited (GIAL)**

Guwahati International Airport Limited (GIAL) Guwahati, managed by Adani Airport Holdings Limited (AAHL), a subsidiary of Adani Enterprises Limited, the flagship company of the globally diversified Adani Group, is the largest private operator of airports in India. GIAL is responsible for the operation and modernization of Lokpriya Gopinath Bardoloi International Airport (LGBI Airport), Guwahati, a key aviation asset and the gateway to Northeast India.

LGBI Airport (IATA: GAU, ICAO: VEGT) with a legacy spanning 67 years, serves as the premier gateway to Northeast India and continues to enhance air connectivity across domestic and international sectors. In FY 2024-25, the airport successfully managed 6.57 million passengers, including 91,594 international passengers and 1,009 international ATMs, along with 45,410 domestic ATMs, marking a significant expansion in global outreach.

With a 'digital-first' philosophy, LGBI Airport is committed to delivering seamless passenger experience, leveraging state-of-the-art technology and modern infrastructure. As a key EXIM and logistics hub, LGBI Airport recorded 12,893 metric tonnes (MT) of cargo in FY 2024-25.

Currently under construction, Terminal 2 at LGBI Airport will elevate passenger capacity to 13.1 million per annum, making it the first terminal of its kind in Northeast India. Inspired by Assam's natural beauty, the terminal will feature a Bamboo Orchids theme, symbolizing biodiversity, strength, and sustainability.

In December 2024, LGBI Airport was recognized for its commitment to customer excellence, achieving Level 2 accreditation by the Airports Council International (ACI) Airport Customer Experience Programme. Further reinforcing its sustainability efforts, the airport received the prestigious Greentech PCWR Award 2024 for Waste Management & Recycling Leadership.
